

- Be sure to call the police so that a police report can be made.
- Be sure to get the other party's insurance information at the scene. The police report may not be available for several days. It may also contain typos or missing information so review it carefully.
- Take photographs of the wrecked vehicles and/or injuries via camera phone or any camera in the car at the scene of the accident.
- Seek medical attention immediately, even if you are not experiencing any pain.
- If a court date is given at the scene, make sure you know when it is.

- Follow-up and obtain a copy of the police report.
- Don't give ANY recorded statements without retaining legal counsel.
- Follow instructions given by medical provider(s) as they will become part of your permanent medical record.
- Keep copies of all medical bills and accident related expenses.
- Be present for the traffic court hearing.
